- ✓ Case Studies and exercises to apply acquired knowledge.

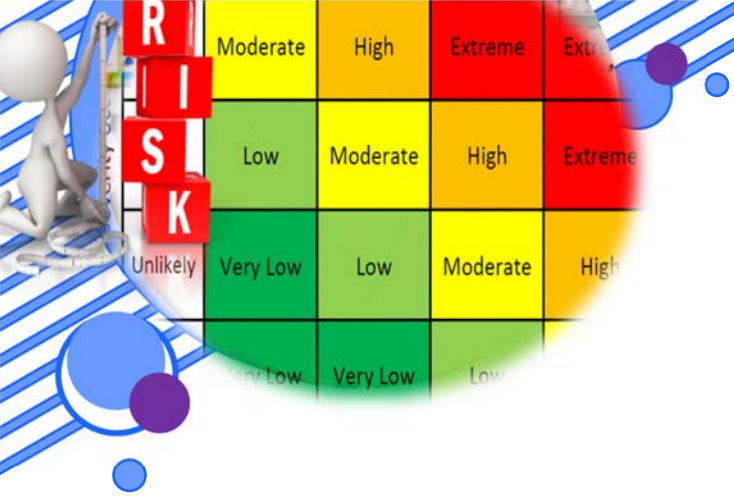
