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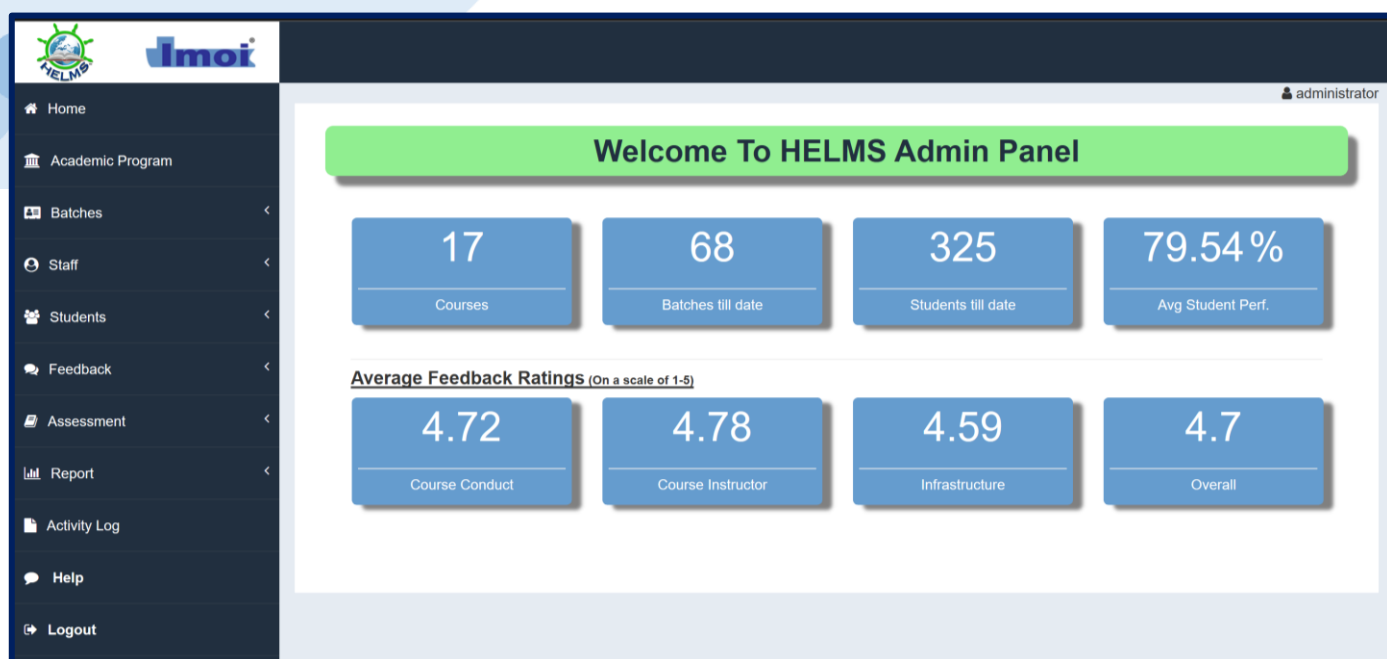

Academic Program: The institute can create unlimited academic programs and courses. Add subject names, topics, sub-topics and corresponding learning material, modules, reference notes, assignments, etc.

Batch: Feature to create several batches for each academic program. For each batch staff can schedule video-conferencing classes, launch the classes, visit forum, update scheduler and create assignments

Staff: The HELMS can maintain a complete list of your faculty and non-teaching staff with the feature to update records. All the staff can be assigned different roles within the HELMS system.

Students: Keep a complete record of full-time and part-time students. Feature to create individual profiles and bulk-upload student data. All students' performance can be tracked, and each student dashboard can be viewed by the administrator.

Assessment: The faculty can create tests and assessments of objective and subjective type for each topic. A subject-wide examination can also be developed by the faculty. All the tests and examinations can be made available to the students and then reviewed by faculty.

Feedback: The system allows for creation of feedback forms, analysis and management of feedback provided by students in the institute. All the students' feedback can be viewed as per Course Conduct, Infrastructure, Course Instructor. Any feedback score below 2/5 is highlighted in red for easy review by the administrator.

Activity Log: The HELMS records all the activity log of its users. This includes **ATTENDANCE** to live classes, login/logout times, access to learning material, access to activities like assessments and assignments, etc. This section helps in compliance with administrative and government record keeping requirements.

Report: The system can generate reports and graphs for all the activities on the portal.
